- Beyond the Bell's mission is to help students achieve grade level proficiency in ELA and Math skills through small group instruction three days a week after school.
- Title 1 Coordinator identifies students in need of support by reviewing a variety of data, including NJSLA scores, IXL Diagnostic Snapshot data, course grades, and recommendations from teachers and or counselors.

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- Students selected are then invited to participate in a six week session.
- Their growth is continually monitored and shared with the students and their parents/guardians.
- When possible, students are invited to additional sessions.

 Due to its success, BTB was expanded this year from supporting 80 sixth graders from November-April of last year, to over 200 sixth and seventh graders to date since October. N I O N

- This year's program will run until the beginning of May.
- We consistently see growth for 85%+ of our participating students.



23-24 School Year Growth

We served 80 sixth grade students from November through April.

ELA:

89% (39 out of 44 students) grew in their proficiency. 50% (22 students) grew by one full grade level or more.

Math: 100% (67 students) grew in their proficiency. 79% (53 students) grew by one full grade level or more.




