Each oral health kit includes the following items:

- One Crest Sparkle Fun toothpaste
- One Sensodyne Pronamel Kids toothpaste
- One Oral-B toothbrush
- One educational card with proper brushing and flossing instructions on one side and a QR code on the other to help families locate a dentist.

These oral health kits are being provided as part of a national partnership initiative supported by the American Dental Association and the Consumer Healthcare Products Association (CHPA) Health in Hand Foundation.
