ORAL MOTOR THERAPY, FEEDING THERAPY CONTRACT AGREEMENT with NEW JERSEY PEDIATRIC FEEDING ASSOCIATES & THERAPY CENTER, LLC

The <u>Union Township School District</u> to employ New Jersey Pediatric Feeding & Therapy Associates, LLC for the provision of oral motor, feeding training. Services are described as follows:

Oral Motor/Feeding Assessment: \$750.00 (per student)

Feeding Training \$175.00 (per student)

## IT IS MUTUALLY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO THAT: I THE SERVICE PROVIDER WILL:

- 1. Perform Oral Motor, Feeding services in accordance with the individual education program (IEP) for the individual;
- 2. Provide the following services through the assigned therapist:
- Set up appropriate treatment plans and establish short and long term goals and objectives for inclusion on the Individual Education Program.
- Assist with selection and/or modifications of equipment, appliances, to meet the student's needs.
- Instruct the student, ancillary staff, and/or teacher in activities to be carried out between treatments.
- 3. Share information regularly with the teacher who coordinates the educational program of identified students.
- 4. Prepare clinical and progress notes for incorporation into the educational records of the students receiving therapy no less often than monthly.



5. New Jersey Pediatric Feeding & Therapy Associates, LLC will provide professional liability insurance for those individuals directly providing service to the student, which will hold harmless the school district for possible incidents, which may occur during treatment provided New Jersey Pediatric Feeding & Therapy Associates, LLC.

Conform to all applicable policies and procedures of <u>The Union Township</u> <u>School District</u> and the New Jersey Regulatory Statutes;

• Not attempt to collect for therapy services from either student, family, or any governmental, private, or public agency other than UNION Township School District agreed upon services;

## 6. The Union Township School District will;

- Be responsible for payment of fees for services rendered by New Jersey Pediatric Feeding & Therapy Associates, LLC.
- Submit payment for charges by the fifth of following month to be approved at the Board of Education's monthly meeting following receipt of such statement;

III. New Jersey Pediatric Feeding & Therapy Associates, LLC will not be bound by <u>The Union Township School District</u> Calendar and will be permitted to execute services despite observable holidays; snow days; etc.

This Agreement would then be amended by mutual agreement.



If both parties agree to the provisions of this contract and no written modifications are requested, this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect until one of the parties gives thirty (30) days notice in writing to the other party of its intention to terminate this Agreement.
