1. Payment of Annual Membership Dues by August 1, 2021
2. Principal's Affidavit by August 1, 2021
3. Coaches' Affidavit by September 15, 2021
4. Board Membership Resolution Card by August 1, 2021

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the fall season, the following additional requirements must be met by October 15, 2021:

1. No outstanding invoices older than **90 days**
2. Fall Participation Survey
3. Maintains a Fall Ineligible Athletes list as per Article V, Section 4, of the NJSIAA Constitution

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the winter season, the following additional requirements must be met by December 15, 2021:

1. No outstanding invoices older than **90 days**
2. Winter Participation Survey
3. Maintains a Winter Ineligible Athletes list as per Article V, Section 4, of the NJSIAA Constitution

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the Spring Season, the following additional requirements must be met by March 15, 2022:

1. No outstanding invoices older than **90 days**.
2. Spring Participation Survey
3. Maintains a Spring Ineligible Athletes list as per Article V, Section 4, of the NJSIAA Constitution

The Board of Education (of a public school) or Chief School Administrator (of a non-public school) hereby adopts as its own policy and agrees to be governed by the Constitution, Bylaws, Rules and Regulations of the NJSIAA.

Administrative Responsibility – NJSIAA must rely upon the voluntary compliance by its member schools in enforcing the eligibility standards set forth in NJSIAA Bylaws, Article V. Toward that end, the Principal of each member school has the affirmative obligation to report to the NJSIAA any violations of these standards. The fact that a school has disclosed that there has been an eligibility violation will not relieve the affected school of sanctions that may be imposed against it, pursuant to Article X of the NJSIAA Bylaws, including the forfeiture of games or events. However, the failure to disclose an eligibility violation may be grounds for imposing additional sanctions upon the offending school.

In addition, a school must maintain a status of "Member in Good Standing" as outlined in the Principal's Affidavit to remain eligible for NJSIAA activities and tournaments.
