member schools in enforcing the eligibility standards set forth in Bylaws, Article V. Toward that end,
the Principal in each member school has the affirmative obligation to report to the NJSIAA any
violations of these standards. The fact that a school has disclosed that there has been an eligibility
violation will not relieve the affected school of sanctions that may be imposed against it, pursuant to
Article X of the Bylaws, including the forfeiture of games or events. However, the failure to disclose
an eligibility violation may be grounds for imposing additional sanctions upon the offending school.

I further certify that I have examined said list and the rules as well as the supplemental eligibility guidelines adopted by the NJSIAA prior to making this affidavit and I am satisfied and certify that the facts stated herein are true.

In addition I am aware that as a member I, or my designee, must maintain our membership in good standing as the second criterion of eligibility for teams and/or individuals to apply for participation in NJSIAA sponsored tournaments/championships. To maintain "Membership in Good Standing: the following conditions must be met for the Fall season by **October 1, 2013:**

1. Payment of Annual Membership Dues – **due September 1, 2013**
2. The Principal's Affidavit
3. The Coaches' Affidavit
4. Board Membership Resolution Card
5. Fall Participation Survey
6. No outstanding invoices older than **90 days**

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the winter season, the following additional requirements must be met by **November 15, 2013:**

1. No outstanding invoices older than **90 days**
2. Winter Participation Survey – **December 13, 2013**

To be eligible for tournaments/championships for the Spring Season, the following additional requirements must be met by **March 15, 2014:**

1. No outstanding invoices older than **90 days.**
2. Spring Participation Survey – **April 4, 2014**
